I. Purpose

To standardize Smyrna School Board of Education policy

II. Authority

Delaware Code, Title 14 § 1049, Policy Making

III. Definitions

Administrative Procedure: The process by which the policy is carried out by the Superintendent.

Board: The Smyrna School District Board of Education.

District: The Smyrna School District.

Superintendent: The Smyrna School District Superintendent of Schools.

Policy: A course or principle of action adopted by the Smyrna School District Board of Education.

IV. Policy Statement

- I. Board policy must be established and voted on by the Board.
- II. Any additions, deletions, or corrections must be voted on in a public meeting unless other specified under Title 1 of the Delaware Code.
- III. Any Board policy can be added, deleted, or changed with a single vote unless otherwise stated in the specific policy.
- IV. All Board policies require a simple majority vote unless otherwise stated in the specific policy.
- V. All additions, corrections, deletions, or changes will be included in Board minutes with the updated policy attached.
- VI. All Board policies will be standardized in the policy format shown by this policy. Requiring the following:

- 1. Times New Roman, font size 12.
- 2. Heading with the Smyrna School District, Section, Title, and Policy Number to match above.
- 3. Purpose, Authority, Definitions, and Policy Statement included in the body of the policy.
- VII. All Board policies will be available electronically through the Smyrna School District website. The District will make a concerted effort to update the website in a timely fashion.
- VIII. If a dispute on Board policy arises, official Board meeting minutes will be used as the policy of record.
- IX. All Board policies must be reviewed at a minimum of once every five years.
- X. All Board policies shall denote the date of creation and the date of any subsequent changes or reviews, below the policy statement.
- XI. As of September 1, 2022, the Superintendent shall maintain a copy of any deleted policies in case they become relevant for future needs of the Smyrna School District. The Superintendent will also try to locate any previously deleted policies.
- XII. Board policies shall not violate any federal or Delaware Law/Code.
- XIII. Any portion of a Board policy violating federal, or Delaware Law/Code shall automatically become void and revert to current laws, code, or regulations.
- XIV. Each Board policy shall reference any Board policies and administrative procedures to which it applies.
- XV. The Superintendent and/or their designee shall maintain the procedures. Each administrative procedure shall reference any Board policies to which it applies.
