Attention, Delaware families: Delaware is moving to a new Student Information System (SIS) that combines several current platforms to offer new features and services. This change will provide better functionality for schools and families while saving taxpayer dollars by eliminating duplicate systems.

Although the SIS operates behind the scenes, it's crucial for services your districts and charter schools provide, such as student registration, enrollment data, school transportation schedules, and medical information.

We are working closely with our piloting districts and charter schools as we transition. At the same time, they are preparing to welcome your children back for the upcoming school year. We appreciate your understanding if these schools (listed below) need extra time to complete student registration, publish bus schedules, or post homeroom rosters.

As with any major change, there may be unforeseen issues. We thank you in advance for your patience as we work through these challenges. We are grateful for the collaboration and support of the districts and charters in our first transition phase, which will ultimately benefit the entire state.
