### HOURS OF OPERATION

- Student arrival will begin at 7:55am. You may not drop off your child prior to this time.
- Your child is considered late after 8:10 am.
- Student dismissal begins at 3:00 pm.

### ATTENDANCE

- When your child is absent and/or late to school please send in a guardian and/or doctor's note to excuse the absence.

#### TRANSPORTATION

- Car Transportation
  - Arrival: Cars come into our lot and circle around the side of the building. Students get out of the car and enter the building from the side. Parents/guardians will then drive in the front of the school where the cars are parked to exit the parking lot.
  - <u>Dismissal</u>: Bus Riders are dismissed first. Then, car riders exit out the side door.
    Parents/guardians will then drive in the front of the school where the cars are parked to exit the parking lot.
  - O Please do NOT go into the bus lane and be mindful when we must stop traffic.
- Bus Transportation
  - o All Buses drop off and load in the bus lane in front of the school.

- Please complete a Meal Benefit Application form located on the district website to determine if your household is eligible to receive free or reduce-price school meals.
- Students may NOT have food delivered to them at school.
- We strongly encourage a <u>labeled water bottle</u> for students as we have refillable stations throughout the school.
