Any student who plans to drive and park on school property *must be 16 years old and no longer driving on a Delaware permit* (out of your first six months). **Please remember that driving to school is a privilege and if the driving rules are not followed, the privilege can be revoked.** Read the driving rules on the back, complete **ALL** parts of the application, and return it to the front office when you purchase your permit. You may not park in the school parking lots without a permit after September 5, 2025.

In order to purchase a tag you must bring the following items when you apply:

☐ **Registration card**

☐ **Proof of insurance**

☐ **Driver's license**

☐ **\$12- cash or check**

☐ **Completed application**

- Temporary tags will be allowed on the premises until the permanent tag is issued.
- It is the student's responsibility to make any changes to their parking permits regarding a new car, tags or if they are no longer driving to school.
- Permits are only valid for the current school year. No permits from previous years will be allowed.
- **Anyone with an obligation may NOT purchase a parking permit until the obligation is satisfied.**
- **ALL CARS MUST HAVE A PARKING TAG VISIBLE, or you will be subject to discipline action and/or loss of driving privilege.**

Parking permits will be available on a first come, first serve basis until all the spots are filled. Please use the dates below to determine when you are able to purchase a permit:

Beginning August 11 th	8:00am – 3:00pm	Class of 2026 (Seniors)
Beginning August 12 th	8:00am – 3:00pm	Class of 2027 (Juniors)
Beginning August 13 th	8:00am – 3:00pm	All others, after 1 st six-month permit *issue date

Remember, driving to school is a privilege. If the student does not abide by the driving rules, the privilege can be revoked and the fee is non-refundable.

Driving Rules & Regulations

Students who wish to drive motor vehicles to the school must enter through the front office. Upon approval of the request, a parking tag **must** be purchased. The cost is \$12.00 per year for any vehicle that will be driven to school. Violations of the school expectations for parking, driving, and/or code of conduct may result in loss of the student's driving privilege as indicated under the Penalty section.

Parking Regulations

- All cars must have a parking decal in the bottom **driver's** side of the windshield.
- Your parking pass reserves a specific space for you. Should you be found parking in a spot that was not assigned to you, your pass could be revoked.
- Do not park in fire lanes, handicapped spaces, along curbs or on the grass.
- Do not park on the Smyrna Middle School campus.
- Do not block other vehicles.
- Do not give your parking permit to another student.
- Please inform the office if you will not need your parking space for a period of time.
- Students must secure permission from an administrator to go to their car during school hours.

Driving Regulations

- Upon arrival to school, proceed into the building in a timely fashion. No loitering in the parking lot.
- Please drive carefully! Your life and others' depend on it.
- Obey the posted speed limit.
- Leaving school without permission will result in the loss of the driving privilege according to the code of conduct.
- Driving privileges may be revoked if regulations are not followed.
- Motorcycles are not permitted on campus, during school hours.

Driving Penalties

Students are to display the same level of responsibility in school as they do while driving. The administration believes that driving to school is indeed a privilege that is tied directly to school and classroom behavior. As a result of this belief, ***discipline referrals can result in the driving privilege being suspended or revoked if deemed necessary by the Administration.***
