## **Car-rider Line Expectations**

- If you are bringing/picking up your child by car you need to use the car-rider line.
- We will continue using our two lane model for drop off and pick up to move as efficiently as possible.
- 3. Both lanes will merge into one as you go to exit the parking lot.
- 4. We are increasing staff presence this year to help with unloading students and speeding up our process. Parents please remain in your vehicles and allow our staff to get your child out of the car.
- 5. Do not pull around cars that are unloading, you must remain in line.
- 6. If there is a need to park and walk your child up, <u>please use the sidewalks</u> when walking up to the building. <u>DO NOT WALK THROUGH THE CAR-RIDER LINE.</u>



## **Walkers Expectations**

- 1. Walker= Students coming to school "on foot" with or without a guardian.
- No car parking will be permitted on School Lane where the cones are lined out.
- 3. Stopping in the middle of the road to let your student out at the walker door will not be permitted. This is a major safety concern and once again if you are traveling by vehicle you need to use our car-rider lanes.
- 4. No parents or family members are allowed entrance into the building through the walker doors. All visitors must report to the front office.

- There is no staff on supervisory duty until 8:30am. Please do not drop your student(s) off without the presence of school staff.
- 2. Our first couple weeks of school will take a little longer for these procedures so please be patient and kind.
- 3. Our students' safety is first priority so please follow all protocols.

- 5. If you need to make any adjustments for your student's dismissal, please make sure you communicate to the office no later than 3:00pm.
- 6. All students must be picked up by 3:45pm. The school building closes at 4:15pm.
