## I. Purpose

To provide a smoke-free learning and working environment in the Smyrna School District.

## II. Authority

Delaware Code, Title 16 § 2903; Department of Education Regulation, 877

## III. Definitions

- 1. Smoking: The action of lighting, inhaling, and/or exhaling the smoke of any substance. This includes but is not limited to, any use or distribution of tobacco and marijuana products.
- 2. Vaping: The action or practice of inhaling and exhaling vapor containing nicotine, THC, marijuana, or any substance.
- 3. School Property: This includes all district-owned buildings, all district-owned property and grounds, all vehicles, and any leased property including vehicles.

## **IV.** Policy Statement

- 1. Smoking and/or vaping is prohibited at all times for all persons in/on School Property.
- 2. Any employee or volunteer who supervises students off school grounds for school sponsored activities is prohibited from smoking and/or vaping. This includes but is not limited to field trips, and extra-curricular and sporting events.
